The JPMorgan Chase Technology Center

- Located on the first two floors of Lyman Hall
- Current capacity for 125 employees
- Has “JPMorgan Chase infrastructure” (ex. *physical security such as card “swipe” access, network security and TelePresence Capabilities*)

Testbed for new technology and Workspace Designs

- A “Paperless” office with minimal paper storage
- **Innovative Technology Features**
(ex. *Wireless environment for desktops, Phones; Use of “VDI - virtual desktops” - Wireless VDI enables remote support, no onsite servers and Minimal cabling*)
- **State of the Art Collaborative Workspaces and Individual Workspaces**
(ex. *adjustable Height Desks, 360° Adjustable Monitor Arms, Removable Privacy Screens*)

Enables Enhanced Collaboration with the SU Community

- Year-round work experience and internship opportunities
- Space for SU faculty and students to conduct research with JPMorgan Chase practitioners “within the JPMorgan Chase infrastructure”
- JPMorgan Chase practitioners on campus to enhance curriculum via guest lecturers and case studies
- Close collaboration with SU’s new Center for Information Security and Assurance Technology (CISAT)
- Community volunteering of Tech Center Employees (in conjunction with SU employees)

Technology Center Areas of Focus
